The e-mail sender was relieved that this particular E.M. did not stand at the head of the line where she was receiving Holy Communion.

Why am I sending this unique communique to you?

1. To remind you that parishioners, at times, scrutinize you as they do the clergy.
2. To remind you that the flu season is coming, and you are requested to wash your hands before Mass. Carrying handiwipes on you may be helpful, though this is not a requirement.
3. To remind you to wash your hands after you distribute Communion.

Another item: please remember to INITIAL the station sheet in the sacristy. If you don't initial and come forward to the altar you may be asked to return to your pew.
