The Peekskill Area Pastor's Association (PAPA) Hot Lunch Program provides meals each weekday for the indigent at the Salvation Army Kitchen in Peekskill. Various local churches and organizations sign up to cook, and serve food for a specific day of the month. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Church cooks hot meals for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month. We have been involved with this organization for approximately 7 years and feed between 50 and 100 people. When a Seton group agrees to cook for a certain month, they are responsible for:

1. shopping for the food (reimbursement can be made by the Midnight Run)
2. preparation of the food (this is done 1 or 2 days before the Tuesday serving date at our school kitchen, which is reserved through the rectory, 914-528-3547)
3. delivery of the food to the soup kitchen by 11:00 am on Tuesday morning (alternate arrangements can be made if no one from the group is available)
4. serving the food, beginning at 12 noon until around 1:00 pm (again, alternate arrangements can be made if no one from the group is available).
